5: DUAL PILOTS – FIRST AID CERTIFICATES

The requirement for Dual Pilots to hold a valid first aid certificate came into effect on 1st January 2022 (for licence renewals and new licence applications). The FSC has taken the decision to revise the duration of first aid course required – Dual Pilots must hold a valid first aid certificate showing completion of a one day first aid course (reduced from a two day course). This change will be incorporated into the latest amendment of the BHPA Technical Manual, to be published shortly.

For Dual Air Experience Instructors, the requirement to hold a valid certificate showing completion of a two day course remains unchanged. Please refer to the Technical Manual for further information.
